



## What to bring/What's ok to bring

- Alarm clock
- Bathrobe, bath towels, shower shoes
- Bedding (blankets, pillows, pillow cases, EXTRA LONG twin sheets, mattress pad)
- Emergency kit (band-aids, blankets, bottled water, warm clothes, flash light, portable radio, extra batteries)
- Laundry items (basket, detergent, hangers)
- Power strips (UL approved with surge protector)
- Small desk lamp – those that clip on are helpful
- Telephone (land-line – simple)
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, razor, feminine hygiene products)
- Personal papers: ATM card/checkbook, copy of birth certificate, health insurance card, driver's license/state ID, social security card – for employment paperwork)
- Rain-wear (rain coat or umbrella)
- School supplies: stapler, scotch tape, pens, pencils, paper, highlighters, backpack, envelopes, notebooks, scissors, tacks
- Small appliances: microwave, small fridge, rice cooker, coffee maker, (no exposed elements)
- Kitchenware (for room snacks) – cup, glass, knife, spoon, fork, bowl, plate, towel, dishcloth
- Computer, printer, paper, ink cartridges, Ethernet cord or wireless card (Labs are available at the college and across the campus so a computer is not mandatory) (wireless NOT in apartments)
- Entertainment: stereo, ipod, head/ear phones, TV, cable cord (remember that walls are thin and some sound systems are too big for this environment) (cable is provided in each room)
- Bicycle and U-lock (only if you really intend to ride – campus is hilly)
- **Apartment residents only:** toilet paper, paper towels, garbage bags, dishes, utensils, toaster, microwave, groceries, cleaning supplies

## What not to bring

- Alcohol (unless over 21) or other drugs and paraphernalia, including hookahs
- Amplified instruments of any type
- Candles, kerosene lanterns, incense or other fire hazardous items
- Extension cords (without an internal circuit breaker), octopus plugs
- Firearms, knives or other weapons
- Fireworks
- Halogen lamps
- Paintball guns, airguns, BB guns
- Pets (except fish – maximum 10 gallon tank)
- Portable heaters
- Skateboards, longboard skateboards, roller skates, in-line skates (may bring, but may not use on campus)
- Hot plates, toaster oven
- Excess furniture – you cannot remove our stock and we cannot store items
- Glow in the dark stars/stickers, paint
- Nails, stickers, double-sided tape or adhesive strips, adhesive hooks, or anything that removes paint: you will be charged for any damage to the walls.
